At the July 24, 2023 City Council Meeting the City Council authorized the development of Council election district maps. The purpose of the August 16, 2023 and August 28, 2023 public hearings was to receive public input on and provide input regarding the composition of potential Council election district boundaries. Following the initial August 16, 2023 and August 28, 2023 public hearings, draft maps of potential Council election district boundaries were published on or before September 6, 2023, for consideration and public input at the September 13, 2023 and September 27, 2023 public hearings. At the September 27, 2023 City Council meeting the City Council will hold a public hearing regarding proposed transition to District Elections of Council Members, including first reading of an ordinance to potentially select and adopt a district map and district election sequencing, including whether the map will be for five districts or four districts with an at-large mayor.
